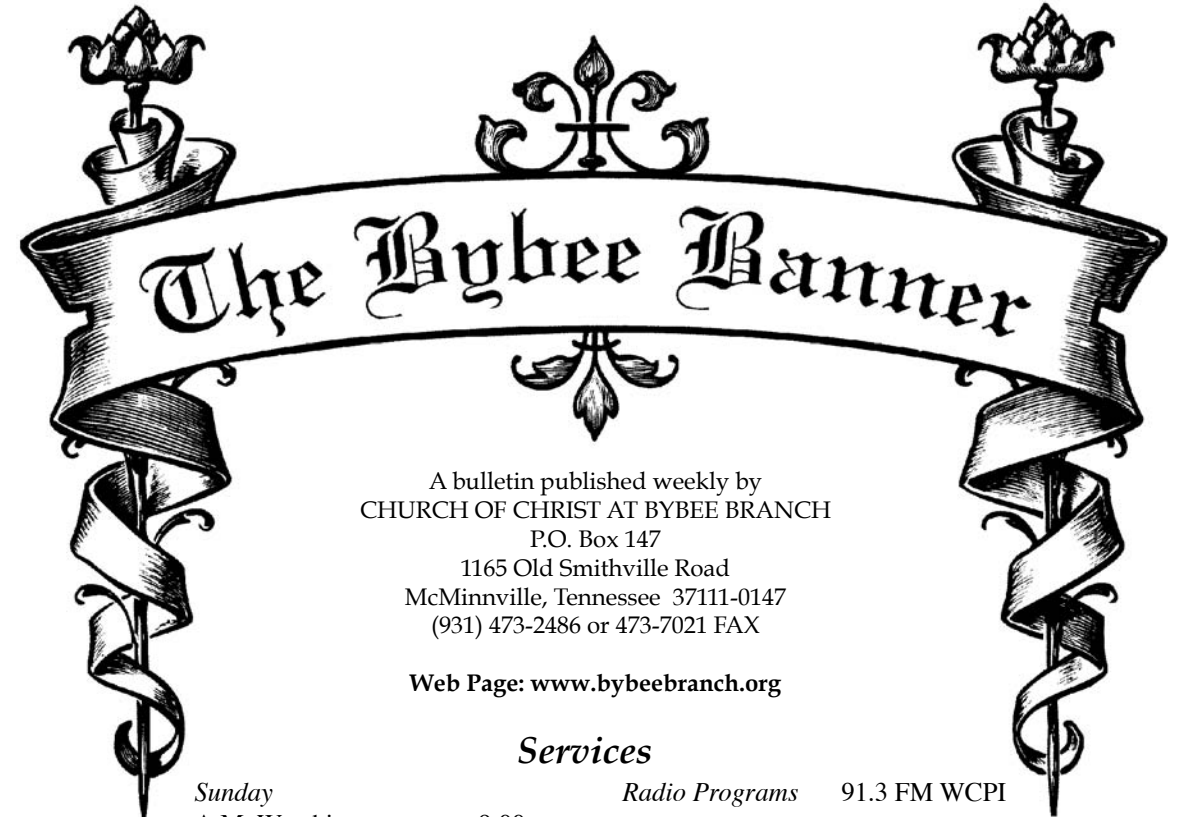

Notes from Steve

The concluding statement of the Preacher of Ecclesiastes sets forth the importance of words with thought and meaning. He stated, *"The Preacher sought to find acceptable words; and what was written was upright - words of truth. The words of the wise are like goads, and the words of scholars are like well-driven nails, given by one Shepherd"* (Ecc. 12:10-11.) The Preacher wanted to implant in the reader's mind that what he was saying was acceptable, truthful, a guide, solid, and unified. What a fitting parallel this is to God's Word as a whole!

The words of the Bible are acceptable or desirable and a statement by King Solomon fits nicely here. He said, *"A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in settings of silver"* (Proverbs 25:11.) The Word of God is truth. Jesus made this vividly clear when he said, *"Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth"* (John 17:17.) The Sacred Word "goads" us along, keeping us on the righteous path. *"Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path,"* is a statement from the Psalmist as found in Psalm 109:105. The Holy Scriptures is like the "well-driven nails" of a master of assembly, built right and built to last. Isaiah (and many years later Simon Peter) presented God's message this way. *"The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever"* (Isaiah 40:7-8; I Peter 1:24-25.) Finally, the Old and New Testaments we use derived from one source. *"...knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit"* (II Peter 1:20-21.) The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are one and when their message was revealed to man, we can rest assured there were no discrepancies.
