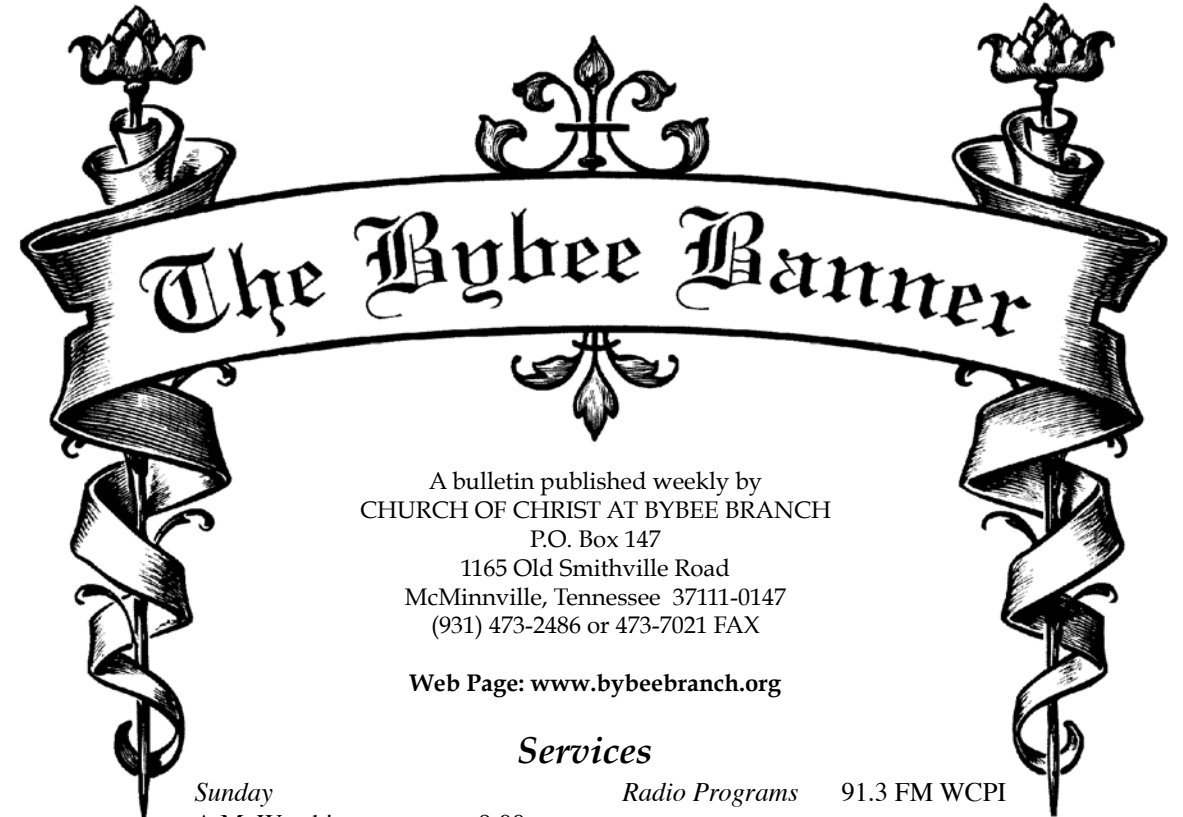

Lessons From Steve

"When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained, What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?" *Psalm 8:3-4*. The Psalmist, probably on a clear warm night, is gazing up at the stars and the moon. He considers the "fingers" that established everything he is viewing and concludes it is the wonderful works of God. However, the more the Psalmist contemplates the work of God, the more he asks: What is it that causes God to acknowledge me, pay attention to me, think about me, even to care about me? As I ask that same question this is the answer I come away with:

LOVE

Open your Bible to *I John 4:9-10* and read about true love. You'll find the love of God is manifested (made known) by the tremendous sacrifice of His Son. God sacrificed His Son that through Jesus we can live. God sacrificed His Son so we could find favor with Him.

Now, look at *I John 4:17-19* and read about this awe-inspiring love. Love has been perfected in our midst so we can have boldness on the day of judgment. We have no need to fear because the love of God has paved the way for us. We are allowed to love God ONLY because He first loved us. Jesus the Christ is our link and the manifestation of God's love.
