Imagine the promise is asking for a child knowing you will have to give that child over to someone else. Hannah made such a promise and kept it, as she gave birth to Samuel then gave him up to the service of the Lord. Hannah would go on to be blessed with five more children and Samuel would grow up to be a light amongst the darkness of Israel. But this all happened because Hannah made a promise and kept it (I Samuel 1:11-28; 2:11.)
