Notes From Steve

Mark Twain once said, "Courage is not the lack of fear. It is acting in spite of it." A truer statement could not be said and can be applied to many situations in life, including those who contemplate giving their life to God. For a person to be wrought with fear, yet refuses to let those fears hinder them from performing the important tasks of life can be counted as very courageous.

As Joshua was preparing to lead the Israelites into Canaan to take possession of the promised land, he must have had mixed feelings about what was going to happen. However, the Lord reminded Joshua to be strong, courageous, and unafraid. God looked to the past when He said, "Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them" Joshua 1:6. The Lord is literally fulfilling a promise made many years ago, so this should serve as occasion to be strong and courageous.

In Joshua 1:7, God reminded Joshua of the present. "Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go." The Israelites now had a law and God is giving them a land, so all they are asked to do is stay on their present path, not veering from it. What strength they should have drawn from the very fact that God was immediately in their midst.

Finally, God states He is before them and will continue to be in the Israelites future if they remained focus on Him. "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go" Joshua 1:9.

We will never be able to rid ourselves of fear, because it is a very natural characteristic. We can, however, teach ourselves to act in spite of whatever anxieties or displeasures may keep us from being true to the God of heaven.
