Notes From Steve

"Then the Lord said to Samuel: 'Behold, I will do something in Israel at which both ears of everyone who hears it will tingle' I Samuel 3:11. Chapter four reveals what this "tingling" was as Israel is defeated by the Philistines, 34,000 Israelite soldiers are killed, the remaining army is running for their lives, Eli's sons are killed, Eli died, and the worst catastrophe of all, the ark of the covenant is captured.
