The youth visited with folks in several nursing and boarding homes on Friday. Then on Saturday they had a couple of service projects in the church building (because of the rain outside work was suspended.) A very messy closet was cleaned out at the church building (containing the old tables and chairs.) A person can actually get to the tables and chairs now! Sunday, however, was the culminating event that made me so proud of our youth. About twenty of them set out to knock doors in the Oakland community with our young men conducting the evening worship. I was amazed (although I should not be) at the energy, zeal and commitment these kids had for going to strangers houses and talking to them about the Lord's church. They visited approximately 130 homes on Sunday afternoon!

What the result will be we do not know. What we do know, however, is that people were invited to hear, talk about, and/or study the gospel of Jesus Christ. As Jesus taught in a certain parable, some will gladly accept the invitation while some will not (Matthew 22:1-14.) Regardless, on this particular afternoon, the youth accomplished a goal that Jesus set forth, which is to tell everyone about His good news (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16.) May nothing but blessings come from the work that was done.

I want to personally commend our elders for allowing the B.B.Y.G. to participate in this program. I know there is a gaping hole when so many of our youth are not in their usual pews, but the fruits of their labor will be evident someday, if not sooner. Additionally, thanks to the Oakland Church of Christ for allowing us to

work in their community and especially letting our young men conduct the evening worship service.
