Notes From Steve

Can we show love for one another, even when having to deal with negativities in Christianity? The apostle Paul certainly thought so. He told the Ephesians that "speaking the truth in love" would help us to grow in Christ (Ephesians 4:15.) Paul expected the church to grow so we could protect ourselves from "every wind of doctrine...the trickery of men, and...the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting: (Ephesians 4:14.) Paul understood the false teachings of his day, but he also determined that without love, most people would turn a deaf ear to God's eternal truth.

Challenging false doctrines need not be done, however, with the absence of love. The word of God is: "... living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12.) "...given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. I charge *you* therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: Preach the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching" (II Timothy 3:16-17; 4:1-2.)

God's word stands on it's own merits and it alone convicts the heart's of men. The Bible is to be preached because it contains information to help soul's determine where they stand eternally. If we can learn to truly love one another, then many doors of opportunity will be opened unto us to

present God's message to family and friends.

Then, with the proper love in our heart, we can approach the dangerous waters of false doctrine and shed the light of truth upon its darkness. Pride and arrogance may get us to the door, but it won't get us in the door.

Please know that if you are a Bible teacher, you are of **GREAT** value. Please don't grow **weary** in well doing, as Paul wrote:

"And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart" Galatians 6:9).
