A New Calendar

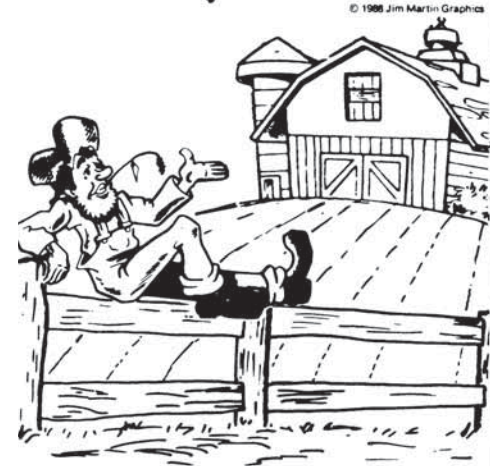
I just unwrapped a new calendar,
