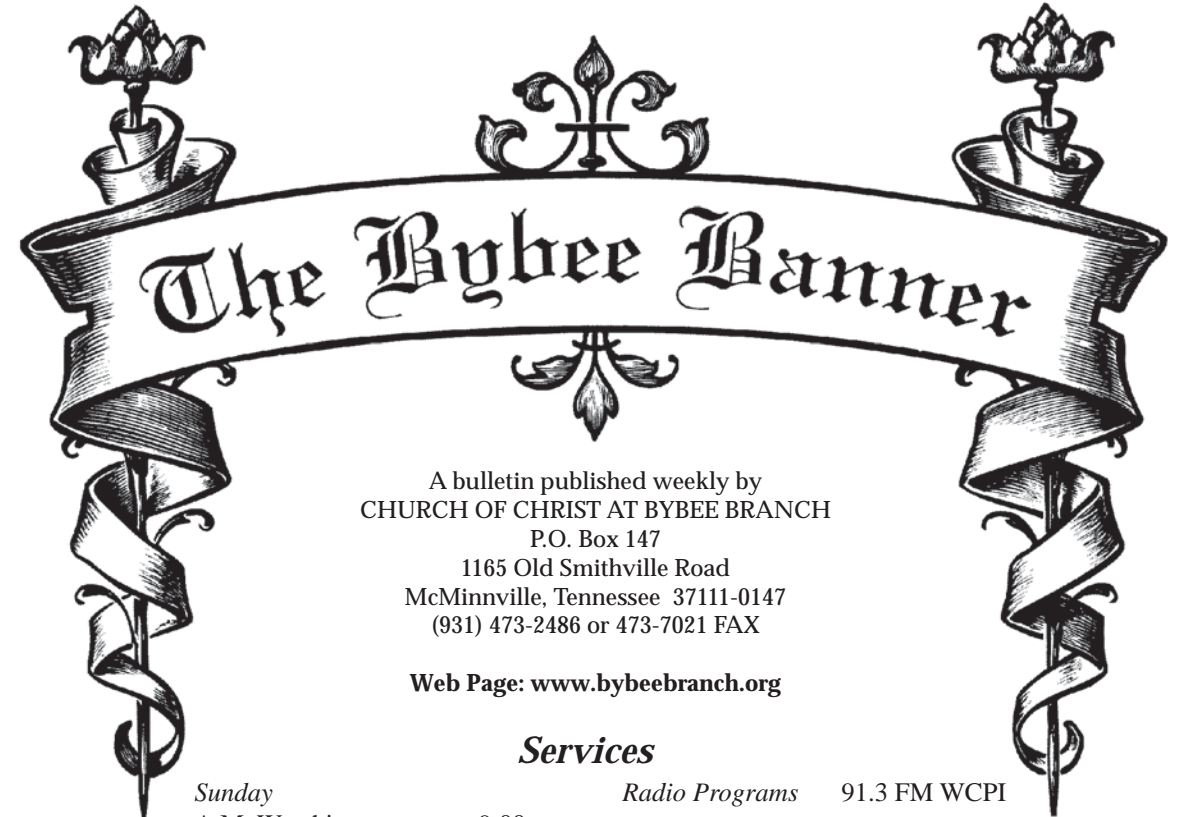

Good Lessons We Can Learn From The Devil

Usually, when we hear the word "Devil," it reminds us of nothing but evil, sin, and wickedness because that is all the Devil means to us. In this article, I would like to examine and analyze the Devil's personality and work, and ironically show you how we can take some good lessons from him by examining the Devil's works and using his own works against him, so we can shake his kingdom rock bottom and glorify the Lord and His kingdom, which shall never be destroyed! (Dan. 2:44)

1. He Never Gives Up

The Devil is never the kind of person who loses heart. He goes about his evil work of trying to destroy people's souls by placing evil distractions along life's road. He doesn't like to see anyone traveling the hard and narrow way. He has been working for over the past 6000 years. In the Bible, we find so many instances when many good people such as David and Samson fell into a deep state of sin. If the Devil doesn't give up, then neither shall we! (2 Cor. 4:16-18)

2. He Has A Mission

If the Devil can tell Jesus of the verse found in Ps. 91:12, he can certainly read Matt. 25:41 where he and his wicked league of angels will be cast into hell forever. Therefore, the Devil has nothing to lose, except to tempt those who were made in God's beautiful image, human beings. He will do everything in his power to get someone to follow him to hell as well. This will determine whose side we are on. If you are a Christian, then you should hate the opposite, which is what the Devil loves! (1 Jn. 2:15-17)
