Just before Jesus was going to be betrayed and killed, Mary did a wonderful deed to the Lord. She took a very expensive container of fragrant ointment and anointed his feet. While some criticized her for such extravagance, the Lord had an entirely different appraisal. He said, "She has done what she could. She has come beforehand to anoint My body for burial." Mark 14:8, NKJV. Consider carefully the phrase, "she has done what she could..."
