Lesson From Steve

I believe that all who went on the Family Matters Retreat this past weekend would agree that the lessons and activities were well worth the trip. The keynotes and classes focused our attention on how culture, especially the media, influences our choices and lifestyles. Television shows, commercials, radio, magazines, etc. lure us into thinking that we must look, feel, and act a certain way if we are to fit into society. This is Satan's trap! He wants us to believe in the world's form of what is right – because with the world nothing is wrong! Paul stated otherwise when he said, “**I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God**” Romans 12:1-2.

Why would Paul not want us to conform to the world? Life would be much easier for God's children if we could just assimilate ourselves into our culture. However, Paul and all inspired writers of God's Holy Word knew this: “**Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God**” James 4:4. Everything God stands for is diametrically opposed to the world. So, God needs people who will stand out from the world, not act like it. Titus 2:14 states “**Who gave himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.**” Jesus did not give Himself so we could parade around as if we had no rules to follow. He expects more. He desires His people to be different. Peter stated it this way, “**But you are a chosen generation, a**

royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;” I Peter 2:9. Notice we are chosen, royal, holy, special NOT TO CONFORM TO THE WORLD – but to proclaim how great God is for delivering us FROM THE WORLD.
