Notes From Steve

"Do I have any pleasure at all that the wicked should die?" says the Lord God, "and not that he should turn from his ways and live? (Ezekiel 18:23.) The Lord is asking a rhetorical question. Of course he does not have pleasure in denouncing the evil of men and women. God wants people to live eternally! God, however, is righteous and just in all His ways and judgments (Acts 10:34-35; Psalm 19:9.)

God, unlike justice systems today, has a standard and keeps it. Some during Ezekiel's day did not agree with God saying, **"The way of the Lord is not fair."** Notice, though, how God responds, **"Hear now, O house of Israel, is it not My way which is fair, and your ways which are not fair?"** (18:25.) Ezekiel pens the Lord's fairness policy by writing **"But when a righteous man turns from his righteousness and commits iniquity...shall he live?"** (18:24.) God is asking, is that fair? Earlier, the Lord had asked, **"Why should the son not bear the guilt of the father?"** God answers by stating that the son did what he was asked to do, which is obeying Him in all things (18:19.) The Holy Father clearly and vividly declares, **"The soul who sins shall die"** (18:20.) Whether we like it or not, that is the finality of God's true justice and righteousness. He has instructed His creation how to live and has spelled out the consequences for not following those instructions.

God loves us (John 3:16) and does not have pleasure in watching His creation perish and lose eternal life (II Peter 3:9; Revelation 3:19.) The ball is in our court, so to speak. The Father sent His Son that all of mankind would have hope meaning Heaven's Glory did His part. Holy blood was shed, so we could live in eternal bliss and approach the throne of God. God will be fair on the Judgment Day. That's His nature, that's who He is. His judgment will be just and right. We, therefore, must make sure we are living in

accordance with His wishes and desires. And what does He desire? **"Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways,"** says the Lord GOD. **"Repent, and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin. Cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit. For why should you die, O house of Israel? For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies,"** says the Lord GOD. **"Therefore turn and live!"** (Ezekiel 18:30-32.)
