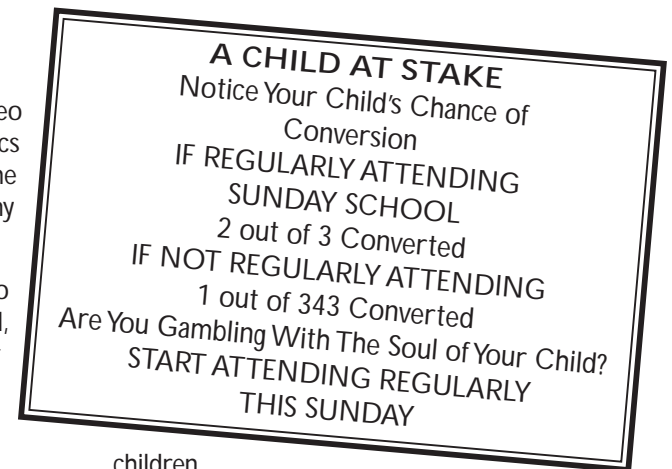

## Bible Class Attendance

The box at the right appeared in the last Mt. Leo Edifier and caught my attention. It gives statistics which I have observed myself to be true. The statistics are so shocking that one wonders why anyone would not attend Sunday School.

Here is what I have observed: Parents who attend Bible study sporadically, or not at all, generally are the the ones who when their children become adolescents get involved with the "wrong crowd" and also the ones whose children "leave the church" when they become adults. These same parents will quite often come to the preacher and want to know what to do to "save" their children. Mentally I am thinking, "you're too late..." You have taught your children by your actions that the church and Bible study are not that important. The children are only believing what their parents have taught them.

Does attendance to Sunday School "guarantee that one's children will become Christians and remain faithful? No, but the chances are much much better! These



children learn there is a better way to live. They learn from the characters of the Bible that there are consequences to sinful behavior. The children develop friends with those who also hold these same values. "20 He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed." Proverbs 13:20, NKJV.
