Summer Series

Our Summer Series starts next week. We will have 8 outstanding speakers on Sunday evenings preaching from great lessons found in Luke's account of the Gospel. Please invite your neighbors and friends to come with you. Let us shoot for a goal of 275 on Sunday evenings.

The first speaker will be brother William Woodson. Brother Woodson is an extremely talented teacher and preacher. He taught 22 years at Freed-Hardeman University where he was the chairman of the Bible Department for 14 years. He also taught several years at David Lipscomb University and was Director of Graduate Studies in Bible. He also preached at the Granny White church of Christ for 14 years. Since his retirement he has spent much time in writing, teaching, and speaking in lectureships and meetings. Brother Woodson has authored three influential books, "Standing for Their Faith: A History of Churches of Christ in Tennessee, 1900-1950," "Sounding Brass and Clanging Cymbals: The History and Significance of Instrumental Music in the Restoration Movement (1827-1968)" and "Change Agents and the Churches of Christ." Brother Woodson continues to teach in the "School of Bible Emphasis" that meets at the Mt. Leo congregation during the school year on the 2nd and 4th Mondays. Be here to hear him preach!
