WHERE DOES THE BIBLE SAY

THOU SHALT NOT GET A DIVORCE?

In Matthew 5:31-32, Jesus said, *"It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife let him give her a writing of divorcement: But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication causeth her commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery."* Notice verse 31, Jesus repeated what was often said in his day. If you want a divorce, get a divorce. Then in verse 32, Jesus gives His teaching on the subject. He said, BUT I SAY unto you. This is a sharp contrast to what was commonly taught. Jesus gave new legislation (from heaven, John 12:48-50) regarding the subject of marriage, divorce and marriage.

In Matthew 19, the Pharisees approached Jesus in an attempt to trap him into contradicting the Law of Moses. Their question was, *"Is it lawful for a man put away his wife for every cause?"* The simple answer of the Lord was, *"What therefore God Hath joined together, let not man put asunder."* This is a principle that began in the Garden of Eden. God's will on the subject of divorce is this: **what God has joined together, man has no right to separate!** But man says, what about "this" situation or what about "that" situation?

However, the principle of God's law is still the same — man has no right to separate what God has joined. No man has a right to say otherwise. No man is smarter than Jesus. No situation can circumvent the Law of Heaven. I am not going to contradict Jesus. What man is brazen enough to step forward and correct the Lord in what he said?

This same principle of marriage is stated in Romans 7:23. *"... The woman which hath an husband is **bound by the law to her husband so long he liveth**; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband So then if while her husband liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man."*

Jesus (heaven) gives ONE EXCEPTION to the principle (rule) of "no divorce." God allows the "innocent" party in a marriage to divorce (put away) a spouse that is "guilty" of fornication (Matthew 19:9; 5:32). There's no other exception.
