

From Tyler's Desk:

Does Jesus Know You Love Him?

One of the first spiritual songs most children learn is "Oh how I love Jesus." The song has a catchy tune and easy lyrics, making it a very easy song for children to learn.

In the same way, it is very easy for people today to claim "I love Jesus." I saw a statistic that 85% of Americans claim to be Christian. This is a vast majority who when asked about Jesus would respond, "I love Jesus." If such a majority of Americans claim to love Jesus, then why are we taught in Matthew 7:13-14 that many will go in by the way which leads to destruction, and few are those who choose the way which leads to life? The answer is found in verse 21. "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven."

Many claim to love Jesus, but the claim alone is not enough. Only those who back up their claim by their actions will enter the kingdom of heaven. In John 14:15 we read, "If you love Me, keep My commandments." And then again in John 15:14, "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."

Does Jesus know you love Him? It is important to tell others of your love for Jesus, but word's alone don't show your love.

Jesus proved His love for us. As the song goes, "Oh how I love Jesus, because He first loved me." Jesus proved this love when he died on the cross for us. "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends" (John 15:13). Jesus first loved us. Do you in return prove your love for Him?
