Miracles in Mark: Feeding the Five-Thousand

Mark 6:30-44 contains a story which many of us have heard since we were very young; the feeding of the five thousand.

As Jesus and his apostles were in a deserted, grassy area, a large crowd of 5000 men, not counting the women and children gathered around Jesus. Being in a deserted area, there were no food vendors near by. So as the evening drew near, the crowd began to grow hungry.

The New Testament is full of instructions concerning the needy:

- Galatians 6:10, "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone..."
- James 1:27, "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction..."
- 1 John 3:17, "But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him?"

Jesus' instructions to his apostles were in harmony with these commandments. He said to them "You give them something to eat."

Jesus instructs us to help the needy. But what do we do if we don't have the resources? With the economy struggling, and Christmas presents to buy, many of us are struggling to find any extra cash. We may tell ourselves "perhaps God will understand if I don't help just this time."

The apostles apparently had the same problem. There were only five loaves and two fish available to feed this large crowd. It would have cost over a half year's wages to buy enough food for a crowd this size. How could Jesus expect them to feed the needy crowd with such meager resources?

As we read, Jesus only needed the five loaves and two fish to feed the entire crowd. If we are willing to give everything we can, God can take care of the rest.

Over the next couple of weeks the youth group will be collecting money to buy Christmas gifts for the needy in our community. The Bybee Branch congregation has always been very generous in supporting this effort. Just as Jesus taught his apostles on that day, may we make every effort to have compassion on the needy.
