From Tyler's Desk:

Where is God's Providence When I Need It?

In last week's bulletin article we observed our God is able to provide for us. He has time to provide for us. He has not and will not change. He understands what we need. And He has demonstrated that he cares for us!

Now for just a moment, we will consider a question which we have all asked, or will be forced to ask at some point in our lives. "Where is God's providence when I need it?"

An inspired penman was once faced with this same question. "My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all the day long, "Where is your God?" (Psalm 42:3).

This was a very low point during the psalmist's life. We don't know what the psalmist was facing, but at times, we can all relate to the psalmist in his pain.

He then begins to remember how happy he was in earlier days. Verse 4 says, "These things I remember, as I pour out my soul: how I would go with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God with glad shouts and songs of praise, a multitude keeping a festival."

Has there ever been a time in your life when in tears, you asked the question, "Where is my God?" We can all remember times when God has blessed us. We can all remember being filled with overflowing joy and

love for life. But now we're faced with the question, "Where is my God?"

At time we find ourselves in messes; trials which seem impossible to overcome. We may find ourselves with no money left to pay the bills. We may be faced with a marriage which seems to be deteriorating before our very eyes. We may find ourselves dealing the death of someone close to us. We may find ourselves sick, depressed, discouraged, or alone.

Where is God now? Has He forgotten to provide for us in our time of need? Has He turned his back on us?

But listen to the words of the psalmist in verse 11. "Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God."

What amazing confidence! We may not see God's providence at all times, but HE DOES PROVIDE!

God has promised that He will provide. Hebrews 13:5 reminds us of this promise: "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

Romans 8:28 reads, "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose."

This does not mean that God will provide all we want or think we need. But if we love the Lord enough to faithfully follow his commandments, no matter what the cost, our trials can be used as a means of providing blessings and spiritual growth.

We serve a God who provides for us, and for that we should continually give thanks.
