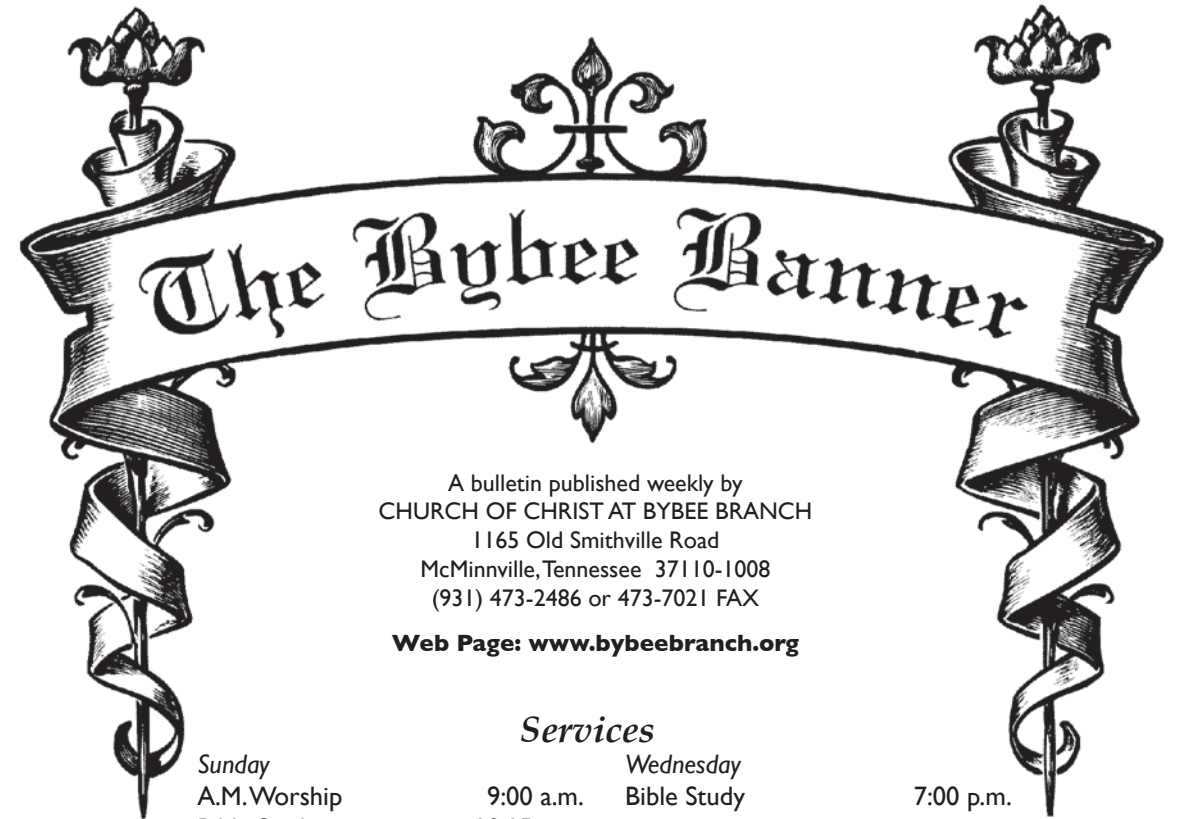

From Tyler's Desk:

Is Everything That Happens God's Will?

In recent bulletin articles we have observed that God continues to work in the world today. God has promised that He will provide and care for us. God is in charge, just as David declares in Psalm 103, "The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all."

But we must also realize that not EVERYTHING that happens is God's will.

In Deuteronomy 30:15-16 we read, "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it."

From these verses we learn that God's providential care and his blessings upon us are conditional upon our obedience to Him. God's providence does not destroy our free will.

Although many married couples end their relationships in painful divorces, we know that divorce is not God's will. Although promises are often broken, it is not God's will for us to go back on our word. Although many souls will one day be lost, we know that God, "desires all people to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4).

God has promised His blessing and providential care for our lives. He has also given us His will for our lives in Scripture, so that "the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:17). Unless we choose to live our lives the way God has told us to live, we cannot enjoy the promise of God's providential care.
