## From Tyler's Desk:

### Support for the Youth Program

I just realized today that I have now been working with Bybee Branch youth group for over a year now! The past year has certainly had its share of challenges for me, but I continue to be overwhelmed by the tremendous amount of love, encouragement and support this congregation has continued to show. As the summer is now upon us, I'd like to remind everyone of some ways in which you can continue to support the young people of this congregation.

1. Host a youth devotional. One of the cornerstones of our youth program is the youth devotionals. Our goal is to have an in-home youth devotional every two weeks. In order for this to happen, we need families who are willing to open up their homes to our youth on Sunday nights and provide food (which can be as easy as ordering pizza!). We are still in need for families to sign up for July 19<sup>th</sup>, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, and August 23<sup>rd</sup>.

2. Organize a "Friday Friends Fellowship". Our goal is to provide a fellowship opportunity for our young people on every Friday during the summer. Organizing one of our "Friday Friends Fellowships" can be as simple as saying "we're meeting at my house at 3 to drive to a park and go hiking". Other fellowship ideas may include movie nights, softball, volleyball, basketball, scavenger hunt, etc. We are in need for people to organize events for June 19<sup>th</sup>, June 26<sup>th</sup>, July 17<sup>th</sup>, July 24<sup>th</sup>, and July 31<sup>st</sup>.

3. Give Financial Support. We never want for any kids to be left out of any youth events because they cannot afford to participate. If you would like to donate to our youth fund, please see Tyler.

4. Provide Encouragement. Get to know our young people and their friends. Let them know you care about them. Write them cards!
