From Tyler's Desk:

Jesus: The Master Teacher

In John 3:2, Nicodemus made a simple, yet profound observation concerning Christ: "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him."

His observation was simple in that his conclusion was obviously clear. There could be no other explanation. At this time, Jesus' reputation as a miracle worker was quickly spreading. He had recently turned water into wine at a wedding feast. And this was just the start. From Cana to Capernaum, to Jerusalem, everywhere Jesus went, he performed signs. Nicodemus clearly followed the logic: If Jesus is doing things that no man can do, God must be with him, and if God is with him, then his teachings must be from God.

Although the conclusion that Jesus was from God was clear to see, its impact was tremendous. Being sent from God, his teaching was not like that of other teachers. Following the Sermon on the Mount, the crowds were astonished, "for he was teaching them as one who had authority, and not as their scribes" (Matt. 7:29). His words mirrored the graciousness of God (Luke 4:22). And while his message was from God, Jesus was still able to connect it to the common man through parables so that his listeners could understand (Mark 4:34).

In response to Nicodemus' observation, Jesus

taught Nicodemus about the kingdom of God – which was the purpose of his preaching (Mark 1:15). As we strive for this spiritual kingdom, we must follow the teachings of the master teacher – Jesus.
