From Tyler's Desk:

Jesus Teaches About Righteousness

“You shall not kill (but its ok to hate!)”

“You shall not commit adultery (but its ok to lust!)”

“You shall not swear falsely (but if you're not swearing, its ok to lie!)”

“You shall love your neighbor (but hate your enemies!)”

These were some of the teachings of the Pharisees. Sometimes the teachings were vocalized; other times they went unsaid. But they were always clearly taught through their hypocrisy.

Sometimes we forget that the Pharisees were LOOKING for the kingdom of God. In fact, the Pharisees prided themselves on being the most holy of all the Jews. They followed God's commandments strictly. They gave to the poor. They prayed and fasted often. Its no wonder so many of them flocked to the man called “Jesus” when he came preaching about the kingdom of heaven. They had hoped to find a warrior, a revolutionary, and a great king who would restore Israel to its former greatness!

But the sermon they heard was not what they expected. Yes, they found a warrior, but his weapon was not a sword. Yes, they found a revolutionary, but the Romans were not his enemies. Yes, they found a king, but his kingdom was not of this world.

As he taught, his sword of truth destroyed *their* teachings. He led a revolution against the idea that following God was simply an outward act. The Pharisees quickly found their own sinful ways to be his enemies.

“Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.” – Matthew 5:19-20

The “righteousness” of the Pharisees was in fact not “righteousness” at all. Its easy to attend church. Its easy to be listed in the directory. Its easy to memorize the steps of salvation. Its easy to label ourselves as “Christians.” But we cannot be a part of His kingdom unless we are changed in our hearts. We must be fully devoted to following him. When our hearts hunger and thirst for righteousness, an obedience to all the commandments will naturally follow. Only then can we truly claim citizenship in His kingdom.

Garbage

Many years ago while a student at Freed-Hardeman University in the class “Preacher And His Work” brother Tom Holland stressed the necessity of the preacher being a faithful and godly man. This was such a practical class but one rich with memorable moments. I recall one of those classes vividly.

While enumerating several things which preachers must avoid he specifically stated that no Christian and especially no preacher should ever go see a “dirty movie.” One student quickly responded to brother Holland with this question: “But, brother Holland, have you ever been to a dirty movie? If not, how do you know what is in them?” To which brother Holland offered a classic answer: “No, I haven't, but I don't have to stick my head in a trash can to know what garbage is...” That response became an oft repeated phrase by many of us who were in that class.

Many times I have reflected upon the profundity of that answer. Does one have to experience sin to know how bad it really is? Obviously not. In Revelation 2:18-29, Jesus addresses the church at Thyatira. Among the problems that existed at that church was a seductive woman in the mold of the Old Testament woman Jezebel. She was seducing people to commit fornication and eat things sacrificed to idols. When prescribing what the church should do he said, “Now to you I say, and to the rest in Thyatira, as many as do not have this doctrine, who have not known the depths of Satan, as they say, I will put on you no other burden.” (Revelation 2:24 NKJV). Key on the phrase, “have not known the depths of Satan, as they say.” Evidently those following this modern day Jezebel were saying, “don't knock it until you have tried it.” Peter described them by saying, “they promise them liberty, they themselves are slaves of corruption;” (2 Peter 2:19 NKJV).

You don't have to try sin out for yourself. Read the Bible and you will know what is the garbage. “Through Your precepts I get understanding; Therefore I hate every false way.” (Psalms 119:104 NKJV).
