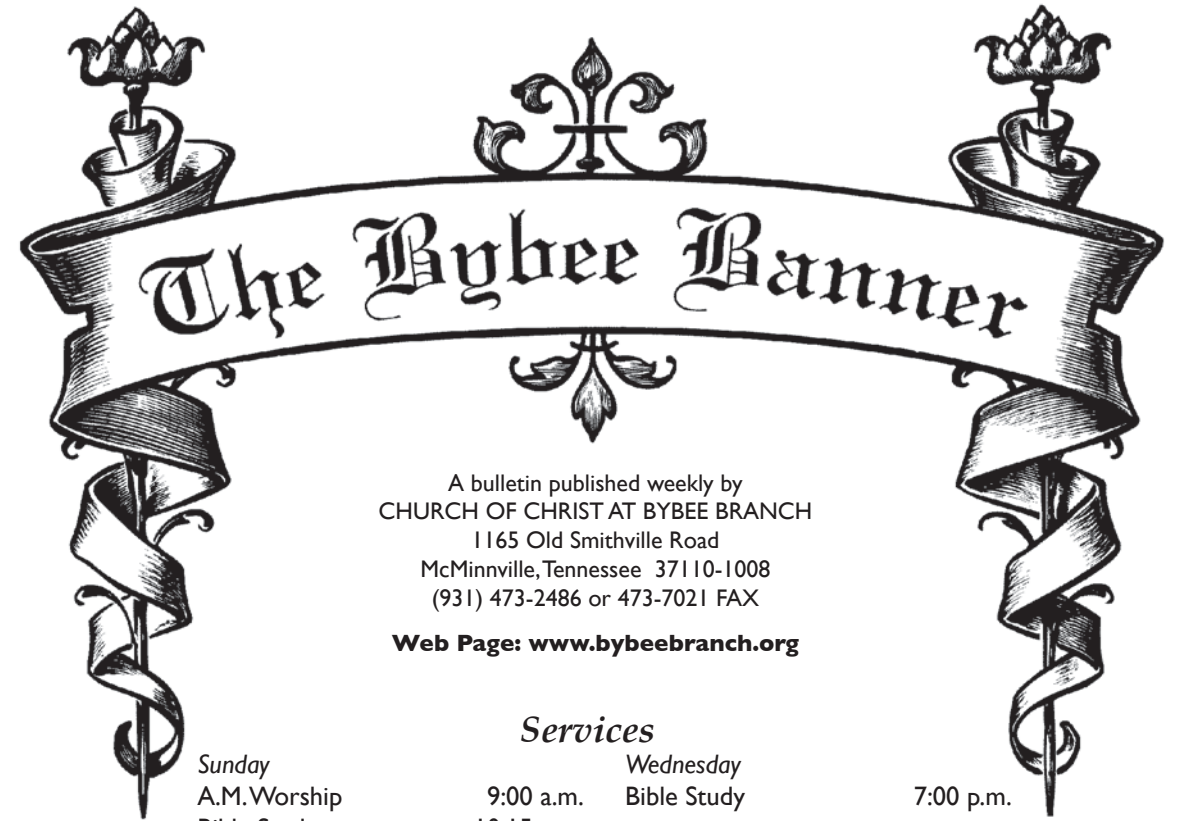

Details for this Sunday
