A Saint Is A Saint

Isn't it curious how some terms used in the Bible have changed in meaning? "Saint" is one such word. According to a modern dictionary the definition is: "A person considered holy and worthy of public veneration, esp. one who has been canonized" (American Heritage Dictionary). A person must pass a series of tests after death in order to even be considered for this designation by some.

The Bible meaning of "saint" is quite different. It is applied to all Christians. In Ephesians 1:1 Paul addresses the faithful in Christ Jesus as "saints." Nowhere in that letter do I find an elite group to whom the term is directed.

There seems to be a presumption here that after death some will be able to influence Jesus or the Father to hear our prayers. There is no indication of this in the Scripture. "And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him" (Col 3:17 (NKJV)). Why would I want to insult Jesus by insinuating that He can't do the job? We don't need lobbyists in Heaven.
