Christianity vs Islam

Critics of a perverted Christianity, who liken it to the practices of Islam are comparing apples to oranges. Muslims commit acts of violence, because their sacred book encourages violence. They do it with the approval of Allah. The Koran contains at least 109 verses that call Muslims to war with nonbelievers. Some are quite graphic, with commands to chop off heads and fingers and kill infidels wherever they may be hiding.

Muslims who do not join the fight are called 'hypocrites' and warned that Allah will send them to Hell if they do not join the slaughter. Muslims are violently cruel to other Muslims with whom they disagree over the slightest matter. They do what they do, because their supposedly inspired writings from their supposed prophet encourage them to do it. They are following the root of their faith.

On the other hand, the Bible teaches Christians to put away their swords (Mt. 26:51ff.), to love enemies (Mt. 5:43-48), to pray for persecutors, and to leave vengeance to God (Rom. 12:19-21). This is the root teaching of Christ, the Prince of Peace.

Some Christians lived in the days of slavery, but the will of Christ and His kindness led to the end of slavery in many countries. While some passages speak to slaves, others speak to masters not to be cruel, knowing they will face the judgment of God (cf. Eph. 6:9). Islam commonly promotes slavery and permits masters to abuse their slaves sexually. Much of human trafficking in the world today has its basis in the supposed permission given by Allah.

The crusades, the inquisition, and witch trials did not come from the heart of Jesus or any teaching of Scripture. The Catholic/Protestant conflicts are works of the flesh, condemned in Scripture (Gal. 5:19-21). It came from a perverted form of Christianity, in opposition to everything the Scriptures stand for. Those who call all Christianity into question because of these perversions, show more prejudice than logic, more bias than understanding. Much of the Crusades began more as a defense of those who traveled to the holy lands than as an abuse of Islam. Those who cruelly abused do not follow the ways of the Lord.

Historically, the enemies of Christ have relentlessly persecuted and abused Christians. Today, Christians face untold misery from the hands of Muslims in several countries. Shooting infidel infants, burning people alive, and beheading anyone who disagrees are not in any way a Christian traits from Scripture; but they are characteristic of the root teaching of the Koran and its supposed prophet.

Why are they different? Because only one follows the Son of God.
