Love Covers Sins

"And above all things have fervent love for one another, for 'love will cover a multitude of sins.'" I Pet. 4:8

Have you ever found it difficult to forgive someone who has genuinely asked for your forgiveness? Perhaps the reason it is so difficult is that you really do not love that person. We can see true love in the heart of our Lord as He begged for forgiveness for those nailing Him to the cross (Lk. 23:34). And yet no greater love could be shown than dying for them (Jn. 15:13). Jesus sought for the opportunity to extend forgiveness. Such also was the will of the Father (Jn. 3:16; Rom. 5:8).

Peter was evidently quoting Solomon, *"Hatred stirs up strife, But love covers all sins."* Pr. 10:12. This passage is an excellent illustration of Hebrew poetry where the two lines are set in contrast. Hate and love are opposite dispositions. "Stirs up" is literally "uncovers" and is set in opposition to "covers." And such attitude would result in strife versus forgiveness. When hatred is unmasked it shows itself in the creation of strife. It does seek or even want things to be peaceful. As David captured the idea so well. *"I am for peace; But when I speak, they are for war."* Ps. 120:7.

Exactly how does this "fervent love" actually work? First, it does not keep a record of wrongs. The "thinks no evil" of I Cor. 13:5 may also be translated "does not keep a record of wrongs" HCSB. Second, it thinks the best of one another. "bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things." I Cor. 13:7. Third, it seeks to turn the one going astray back to the Truth. *"19 Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, 20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins."* Jas. 5:19-20.

Perhaps we have too long looked at forgiving someone else as a drudging obligation rather than teaching genuine fervent love for one another. Rather than being something I *have to do*, it should be something that I *want to do*.
