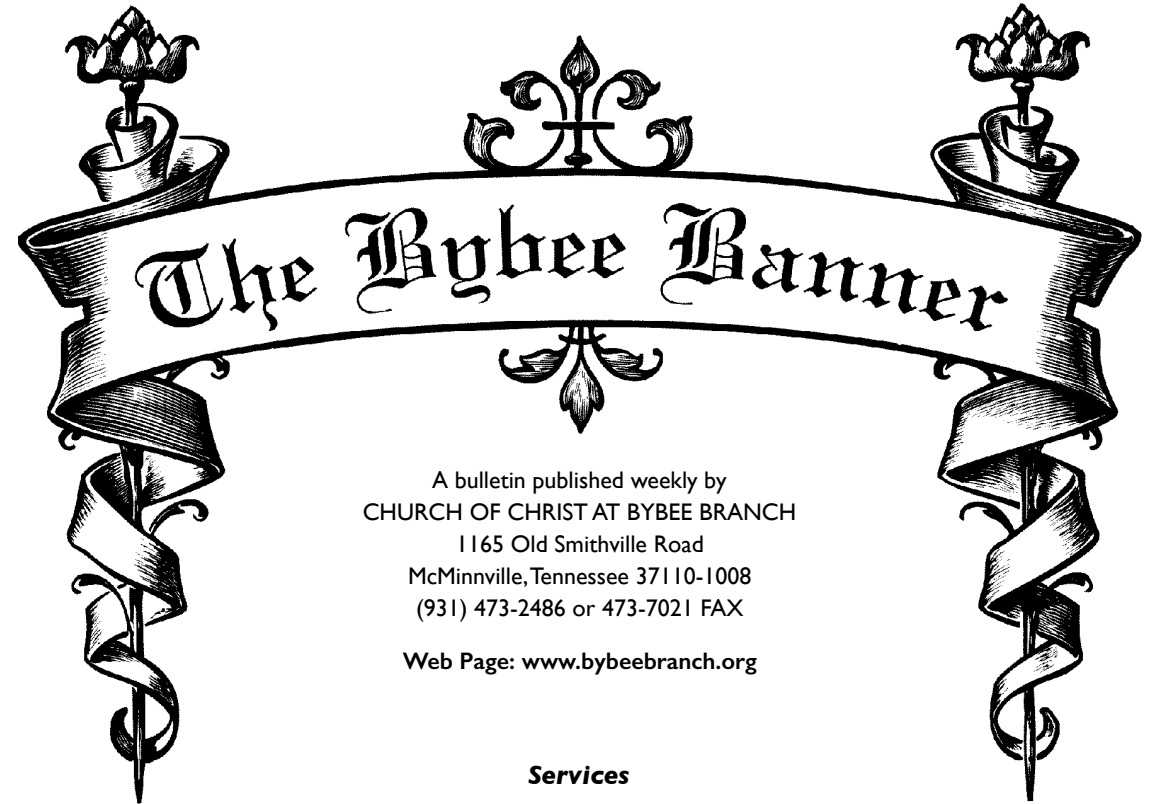

This is Brother Archer Moses and family sending you greetings. It has been a great privilege to be preaching in the Kingdom of Christ. We have 62 members baptized into Christ of which 41 are active and 21 have to leave the village to go out to work to earn an income for their family support. Also, we have a lot of visiting friends to our worship services on Sundays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The average attendance of both the Church and friends are 50.

The Church has made a good working relationship and therefore wants me to work until death. We have also started a project that will earn income to purchase a church transportation to assist us in doing mission work in nearby communities. We know of congregations that is suffering from not having encouragement through visit by brothers and sisters. We want to know who are our brothers and sisters. The second reason for having this transport is to assist the village in emergency cases.

The entire aim for having this project is to show to the world how God's people can unite together in one body to reach this goal despite of things that will come to discourage our plans. We believe togetherness and unity will bring success under the direction of the Good Shepherd.

This project is furniture making and our customers are people within the village. This project has made good connections with the village captain. We all was surprised with his statement which said, The Church has been recognized in the community and encourages us to have full respect for the Church and not to bring shame.

Yes we believe it is recognized by the true light that is shown by the good work of the members. We are asking that you may pray for us so that we all can remain strong in the Lord and in the power of his might. I would like to thank you all for the financial support which we receive every month. With this support we hope to bring many souls through teaching and preaching.
