Acappella

I love acappella music as much as anyone. The word acappella that comes out of early church history is congregational singing without instruments. Calling a "voices-only" presentation "acappella" shows a fundamental misunderstanding of the term. The word "acappella" in this generation has come to be known as a genre, a style of music, wherein a small group sings to a large group accompanied by (nonverbal) vocal sounds to imitate musical instruments. This element strays from the concept taught in the New Testament, where worship in song is always and only verbal. Such groups are popular and often fit more into the category of entertainment than the category of worship. They have their own microphones; they stage themselves like performers. The focus seems to be on them rather than on the Lord.

Recently we recorded a SEARCH singing. It was in the true sense of the word "acappella." Our singing was from the assembled congregation, not a select group. Our purpose was not to sell anything but to praise God; we recorded our music to encourage others who worship with us as they watch SEARCH. We did not make sounds that imitate instruments but spoke, confessed, taught, admonished, praised, and thanked God verbally, as Scripture teaches.

I believe it is confusing to promote this new performing style of music, calling it something it is not. Just because it is voices only does not sanctify the abuses to worship.
