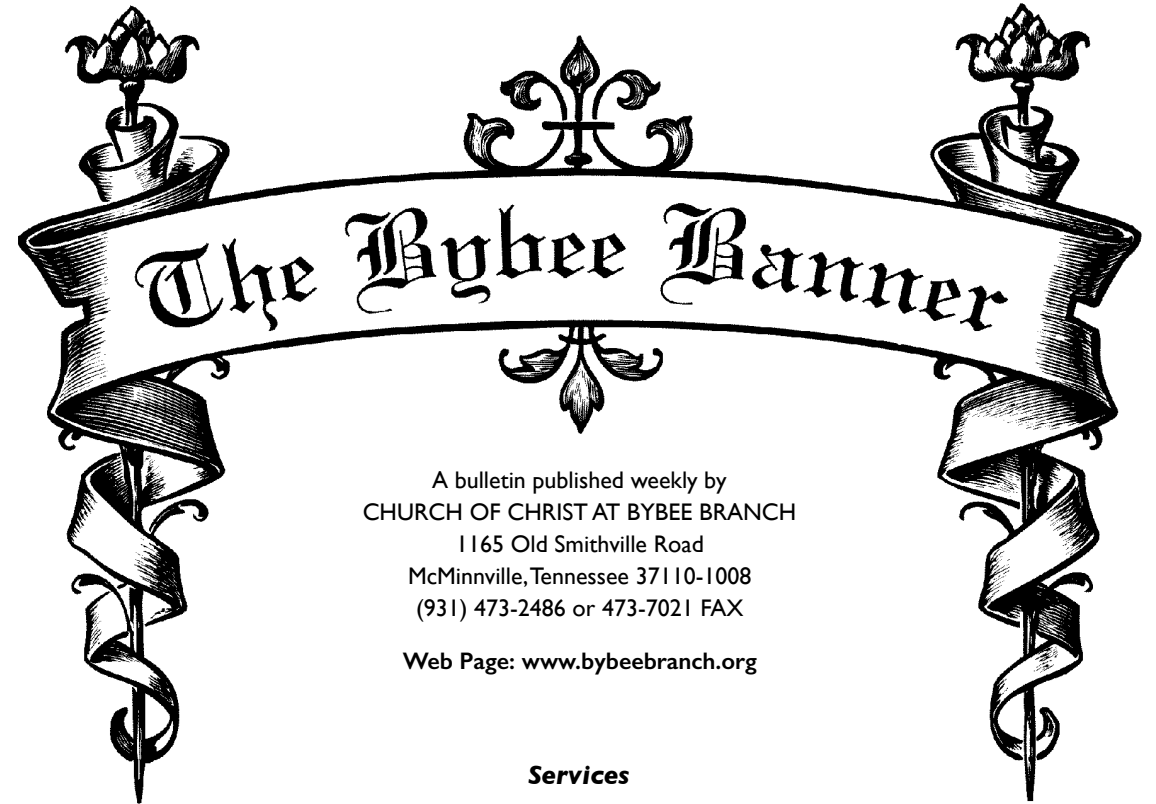

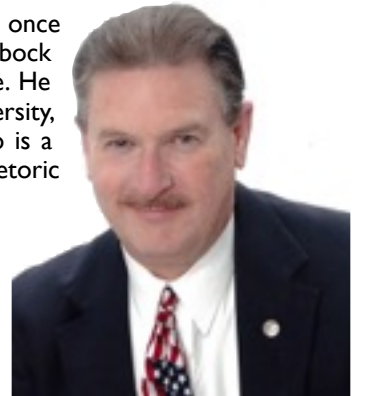
Summer Series Speaker

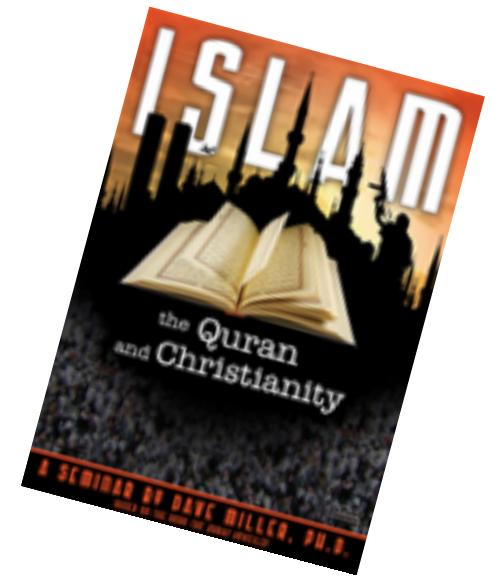
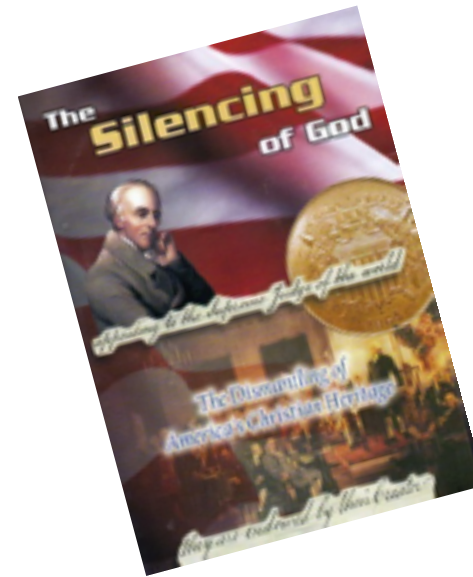
Special Lessons This Sunday by Dave Miller
