Our Inheritance

People sometimes lament about how others have received a "large inheritance," but they have or will receive little or none. It is not uncommon to hear of family members, like the man Jesus encountered in Luke 12:13, falling out over the family estate. As Christians, we do well to remember that "our inheritance is out of this world."

Words like "inheritance," "inherit," and "heirs" are found numerous times in the New Testament. Paul wrote, "The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs – heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together" (Romans 8:16-17).

Take your concordance and study the above words. You will find that "we have obtained an inheritance" (Ephesians 1:18) and that our inheritance is "in the kingdom of Christ and God" (Ephesians 5:5). Jesus has "qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light" (Colossians 1:12). We have "the promise of the eternal inheritance" (Hebrews 9:15). Peter describes our inheritance as "incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you" (1 Peter 1:4).

To receive the inheritance those who would be heirs must meet the terms of the will. Is the New Testament not "the last will and testament of Christ"? To receive the inheritance takes two things: the Word and faith that obeys God! First, it takes the Word of God! The Word is "able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified" (Acts 20:32). Second, it takes faith that obeys God! The Lord told Paul that his mission was to preach the gospel so that people could "receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith" in Him (Acts 26:18). Please note how both of references stress sanctification. The word "sanctified" (hagiazō) means to be separated and consecrated to God.

On that great day the righteous will hear the King say, "Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom of God prepared for you from the foundation of the world" (Matthew 25:34). Get in the word! Obey the gospel! Live by faith! Be holy! The inheritance is out of this world!
