

He started by saying that he had grown up in a medium sized town and his family was your average family. He was married with two children. He was living a normal life, just the way a movie would portray.

One day while the family was sitting on the couch watching tv the doorbell rang and the man went to the door. When he opened the door there was a young man and women about his age standing there with some flyers in there hands. They simply asked if his family attended services anywhere. When the man answered no, the man and women asked if they could talk to him and his wife for a few minutes? He agreed and invited them. The couple and family made small talk, trying to get comfortable with each other.

He went on to tell of how the visiting couple asked them a question during the visit that made him sit in silence for a minute or two. His wife tried to speak but no words would come out. The two kids looked at their parents in confusion. The man and women that knocked on the door had simply asked this family, if you were to die right now would you go to heaven? This shocked the family and made them sit in silence thinking. The husband began to smile to try and break the awkwardness and said I hope. While his wife answered she would like to think so.

You see the family knew what Heaven and Hell was, but they didn't know how to guarantee they went to heaven. They had never searched what they need to do to be able to go to heaven. The family thought they had a great life and then these two random people come in and ask one question that makes them begin to question things and think past next week, next month, and even past next year.

This family insisted that the man and women that had knocked on their door come back and tell

them how they could know for sure that when they died they would go to Heaven. So the man and women started studying the Bible with the family. Quickly the family learned that they were not following what the Bible teaches. They asked several questions over the next seven Monday night studies.
