Outstanding Job

During pew packers yesterday, we played Bible jeopardy. The class was divided into two teams and then we played for the first thirty minutes of class. Some of the questions were about the plan of salvation and the acts of worship, while some were on creation and the books of the Bible. The class afterwards told me that they would rather play games like that then to hear me talk for thirty-five minutes. (Now I know where I stand lol). Although that's not what stood out to me. After the class I was impressed once again with these kids.

The pew packers class has been given a small memorization booklet. Each book has nine pages of Bible knowledge for them to memorize. It varies from the books of the Bible, the twelve apostles, to the ten plagues. After class yesterday I asked them if anyone wanted to try and recite some of these pages from memory. I believe that nine or ten children got in a line to try and one by one they would quote different pages in this book. There was no complaining, no bickering. While they were in line they were helping each other, to get their certain page memorized. It is a true blessing to be working with the youth here.

When I first asked them about doing this booklet I asked them what would they like to receive after they had memorized the entire book. I was shocked when I heard the answer. I was thinking candy, pizza, ice cream, stuff that I, as a kid, would want. But then one young lady said she wants a new Bible. The rest of the class when they heard this all screamed YES!!! Please can we get a new Bible. I was in shock. The girls said they would like to have a colored Bible, like pink or purple, while the boys wanted a black or camouflage Bible. I was speechless for a few seconds and to be honest a little choked up. Several of the class have already memorized several pages.

This class is made up of kids ranging from three years old up to twelve years old.

I wish that everyone could have seen these kids yesterday in class and while waiting in line. They

were working together as a team to try and answer the questions from Bible jeopardy and helping each other while standing in line waiting to get to me for me to sign my name on the page that they memorized. Please encourage all the youth here as often as you can. They are doing a great job.

Special note of thanks for all those parents, grandparents, and others that are working with the kids at home to memorize these booklets. It takes all of us to raise these kids in Gods word.
