Excerpt from Feb. 10, 1949

Gospel Advocate

W. H. Owen, 204 Garfield Street, McMinnville, Tenn .. January 29: "My work with the Bybee Branch Church is now in its fourth year. Under the leadership of efficient elders, the church is making progress. A little more than ten years ago eight faithful souls began meeting for worship in the Bybee Branch Schoolhouse, just outside the limits on the Smithville Road. We now have a membership of approximately one hundred fifty. Attendance and contribution have more than doubled within the past three years. We have a neat, comfortable, commodious building, with classrooms in the basement, well seated, well lighted, well heated, and well ventilated, and no church debt. This has been accomplished without asking for outside help. We are at peace among ourselves, and are not bothered by 'isms' or cranky notions. So far as I know, there has never been any sign of division or friction in the congregation. We are a unit in our determination to adhere strictly to the New Testament pattern in all things. All have a mind to work. So far as I know, no one has ever defaulted on a task assigned him or her. It is indeed a pleasure to work with such a group."

Several asked that I put the article in the bulletin that was referenced last Wednesday night during the invitation. It speaks well of the brethren who were serving the Lord here at that time. It also reflects is that the congregation with great attitudes. When the history of our generation is written, may the same be said of us. I think it will! T.L.

The Book Of Life

In Revelation 20:11-15 John described the vision he saw of the Judgment. In verse 12, he said, "And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and the books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life." In verse 15, he added, "Then anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire."

There are even references in the Old Testament to the Book of Life. Consider the following:

- In the conversation between Moses and the Lord, both spoke about being blotted out of God's book (Exodus 32:32-33).
- David alluded to it when He wrote, "Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous" (Psalm 69:28).
- Malachi 3:16 made reference to "a book of remembrance" written before the Lord.

You want your name to be in the Book of Life! Is it there? Consider the following:

- When we obey the gospel (repent and are baptized) the Lord saves us and adds us to the church (Acts 2:36-47).
- Those who are members of the church are "registered in heaven" (Hebrews 12:23), i.e., their name is in the Book of Life.
- The Bible teaches that "only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life" will go to heaven (Revelation 21:27).
- You want to obey the gospel, be saved, added to the church and have your name written in the Book of Life!
- You also want to be faithful! If we are not faithful as Christians, our names will be "blotted out" of the Book of Life. Consider the following:
- Writing to the church, i.e., to Christians at Sardis, the Master said, "He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life..." (Revelation 3:5). "Blot out" (*exaleipho*) means "to wipe off" or "to erase."
- Obviously, the doctrine of "once saved always saved" is not true! We must "hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end" (Hebrews 3:14) The Master said, "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life" (Revelation 2:10).

If you are not a Christian, you need to obey the gospel so that your name will be written in the Book of Life! If your name has been erased because of your unfaithfulness, you need to repent and ask for God's forgiveness! Only those in the Book of Life are going to heaven (Revelation 21:27)! Those not in the book are going to hell (Revelation 20:15)! To the faithful, the Master said, "rejoice because your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10:20).
