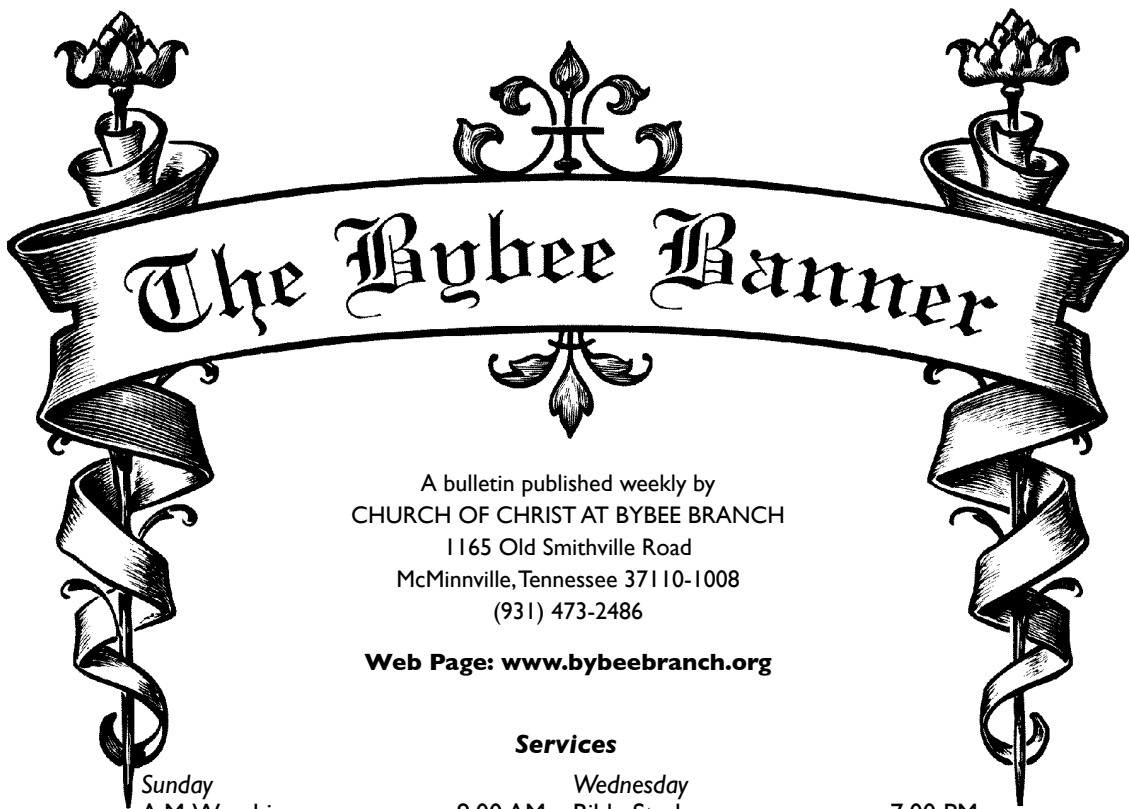

No Excuse

Discipleship (or some form of it) is a word that we read in the the Bible.

Here is a definition of the word disciple: In Christianity, disciple is a dedicated follower of Jesus. This term is found in the New Testament only in the Gospels and Acts. In the ancient world, a disciple is a follower or adherent of a teacher. Discipleship is not the same as being a student in the modern sense. A disciple in the ancient biblical world actively imitated both the life and teaching of the master. It was a deliberate apprenticeship which made the fully formed disciple a living copy of the master.

Sadly this definition is one that is seen as a Biblical practice that only took place during the time of Jesus through the end of the writing of the New Testament. In our modern times the word disciple or discipleship is looked down upon as if someone is has adapted a radical form of Christianity. No longer are people being disciplined for Christ.

I want to look at the last sentence of the definition above “It was a deliberate apprenticeship which made the fully formed disciple a living copy of the master.” How many Christians today are working on themselves to make themselves a living copy of Jesus?

How many Christians are purposefully, consistently, and intently, doing everything they can to make sure, not only they are following in the footsteps of the master, but their wife, their husband, their children are following the same path?

Are they taking steps to make sure their spouse will be with Jesus when they die? Are they taking steps to make sure their children will be in heaven when they die? These questions are not a matter of IF they will die, but WHEN they die.

There are a lot of things in this life that we can avoid. We take precautions and safety measures in order to avoid those bad things in this life, but the one thing we cannot avoid is death. We all will eventually die, the question that remains is this “Where are we going to go when we die”? Are you discipling your family so that when they die, their life was so lived for God that they will be with Him?
