# When Are We Saved?

There seems to be a misunderstanding of what the Scriptures teach about salvation. I've heard people say that they were "saved" and then later on you see that person or someone they're talking about being baptized.

God has always required blood for a sacrifice. Jesus died on the cross, shedding his blood as the perfect sacrifice for our salvation. Hebrews 10:4 & 14 says "4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins." "14 For by one offering He (being Jesus) has perfected forever those who are being sanctified."

The only way a person is saved is by coming in contact with the blood of Jesus Christ. If you think you are saved prior to being baptized into the blood of Jesus Christ, you have what is known as a BLOODLESS salvation and Jesus died in vain.

Mark 16:15, 16 - And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes AND is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

It is obvious if a person does not believe then they will not move forward with the physical act of baptism, which is where we come in contact with the blood of Jesus Christ.

Acts 2:36-38 - "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" Then Peter said to them, "Repent, AND let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ FOR the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

You see, in the very first gospel sermon preached, after Jesus ascended into heaven, the people asked what they needed to do to be saved.

They were told to be baptized **FOR** the remission of their sins. They were **NOT** told that they could be saved without the baptism. They were told to be baptized **FOR** the remission of their sins. Remission of sins means a person has been cleansed of all of their sins, and they are saved **AT THE POINT** of remission.

So if the apostle Peter plainly states (from the command that Jesus gave him) that the only way you can have your sins forgiven/remitted (canceled, taken away, blotted out) is through baptism in Jesus' name, why do so many people think that they can be saved prior to baptism or without it?

Salvation can only come through Jesus Christ and His blood. We must be covered in that blood to have our sins remitted. We come in contact with His blood in the waters of baptism. All other "salvation" teachings are simply wrong.

Don't take my word for it, look in the Bible to find the answer.
