

## What Do They Really Need?

Last weekend there was a group of 19 from the church here that went to Challenge Youth Conference in Pigeon Forge, TN. It is a time of fun, bonding as brother and sister in Christ and being encouraged to deepen your relationship with God.

This years theme was 'Are You Listening'. There were several good messages delivered through the weekend, however there was one lesson that stood out amongst the rest.

On Friday night brother TJ Kirk (VP of student Services Freed Hardeman University) delivered a powerful message on Listening for God.

In his lesson he pointed out several suggestion to help us listen FOR not TO God I.e., get beyond the distractions, know WHAT you are listing for, etc.

Of all the things he said that evening, there was one that stood out more to me than the others. He told of his childhood and how he had a bad father. He said his father was so bad that he would pray that God would kill him.

Several years later, when in college, he received a phone call from his mom about his dad (*l can't tell it like he did*) and his dad died; he died to Christ and became a child of God.

I keep replaying that moment he spoke of in my head. I wonder how many times we have been hurt and we pray for he worst to happen to people, when in reality what those people really need is Jesus.

The next time you are hurt, please don't wish evil on that person, but rather pray they find Jesus before it is everlastingly too late.
