



Gospel Meetings

What is the purpose of a gospel meeting?

If you were to ask this question 50 years ago, you might get a response of "To provide an opportunity for a church to evangelize their community, seeking out the lost and bring them the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ".

 They are an opportunity for Christians to fellowship with one another, outside of regular schedule services.

3. It is an opportunity for a fresh, new voice to bring a gospel message to both the saved and lost.

Yes, 50 years ago you would see dozens of people obey the gospel, verses maybe one person in todays society. However, that one soul is just as important as the dozens of souls.

"12 "What do you think?
