

Reactions To God's Truth

A few weeks ago I decided to that it would be beneficial to have some charts from a previous generation reproduced in the Bybee Banner. This week features another one that comes from brother Titus Ward. I am still convinced that many of us are visual learners and being able to see something will help seal that concept in our minds.

The chart below focuses on the various reactions that one might have towards God's Truth. It is His Truth. "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth." (John 17:17). Only by knowing the Truth can one be set free from sin. "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:32). The Truth of God's word is what every faithful man should preach. Note the wisdom of Solomon, "The Preacher sought to find acceptable words; and what was written was upright—words of truth." (Ecclesiastes 12:10). Such was what Paul preached to Festus, "But he said, "I am not mad, most noble Festus, but speak the words of truth and reason." (Acts 26:25).

However, with whatever fervor and talent one may preach there will always be varying responses to that message. As Paul wrote to the Romans, "But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" (Romans 10:16). Faithful preachers of the Truth are passionate about the urgency of the message. They know the seriousness of one response. Paul wrote, "10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad. I I Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men..." (2 Corinthians 5:10-11).
