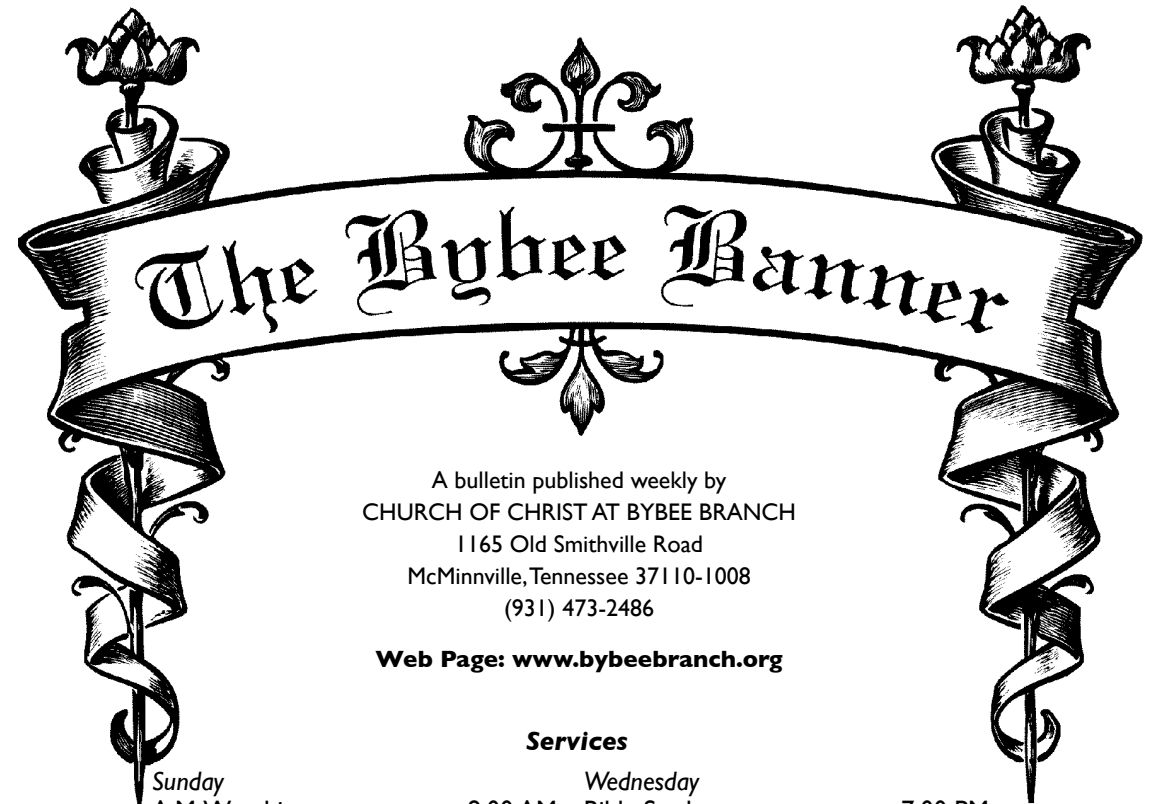

We Wish To See Jesus

There were Gentile "God-fearers" who would periodically attend the Jewish feasts. In John 12, there were some who came to Jerusalem to worship. "Now there were certain Greeks among those who came up to worship at the feast. Then they came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and asked him, saying, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus." (John 12:20-21). Having heard about Jesus they wanted to "see" Him. There are still people seeking to see Jesus today. But how? Jesus died, resurrected and ascended back to the Father. I would suggest that when one comes to us as they did to Philip that we can still show them Jesus. Let me suggest two ways:

One can see Jesus in **Scripture**. In fact, Jesus said, "You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me." (John 5:39). There are numerous prophecies that foretold His coming. In addition there are the accounts provided by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John that record the life of Christ. There such beautiful harmony in the four accounts of the life of Christ that one can "visualize" the things He said and did. They were recorded for us to believe in Him. "And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." (John 20:30-31).

One can also see Jesus in the lives of His **saints**. We are called to "walk in His steps" (1 Peter 2:21) and to imitate Him (1 Corinthians 11:1). One of my favorite songs that I learned in college was "Have You Seen Jesus My Lord."

When people want to see Jesus, let's show Him to them.

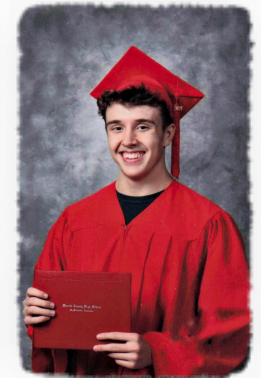
