## **Peru Mission Report**

Delanie Sullivan recently returned from a very successful week-long mission trip to Chimboté, Perú. The campaign was organized through Latin American Missions, a work overseen by the elders of the Forrest Park Church of Christ in Valdosta, GA, Her team consisted of 40 members of the Church from across the U.S. and about 50 brothers and sisters from across the country of Perú. Their goals were evangelism, support of the local church, and to provide medical services to the community. Throughout the week, many doors were knocked and invitations issued. There were 273 Bible studies held which included 604 students and eventually led to 11 baptisms. The medical team also saw 1017 patients, provided 4366 prescriptions, and provided dental services to 404 patients. The congregation at Bybee Branch donated a very large number of eyeglasses, all of which were given to those in need, and the Ladies Bible class sent 80 bears, all of whom found homes with the children of Perú. She thanks you all for your support and prayers! Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in Perú and that the work there may continue.
