

- II. Abstain from sexual sin (IThess. 4:3)
- Prioritize serving God over pleasing men (Gal. 1:10)
- 13. Pray for all people everywhere, especially government authorities (1 Tim. 2:1-3)
- 14. Take care of your parents and grandparents in their time of need (1 Tim. 5:4)

15. Trust in God and seek him diligently (Heb. 11:6)

- 16. Help others see their need for salvation and introduce them to the truth (I Tim. 2:4; 2 Pet. 3:9)
- 17. Live life in the Spirit (Rom. 8:8-9)
- 18. Bear fruit (John 15:1-8)
