

## Comfort and Hope When a Loved One Passes

The loss of a loved one within the church family  
brings deep sorrow. Death is a painful reality of life  
in a fallen world, and even faithful Christians feel  
the weight of grief. The Bible does not minimize  
this pain. When Lazarus died, "Jesus wept" (John  
11:35). Our Lord's tears remind us that grief is not

a lack of faith; it is a natural response to separation.  
As a congregation, we "weep with those who  
weep" (Romans 12:15), sharing one another's  
burdens in times of sorrow.

Scripture also teaches us that death is an enemy, yet  
one that has been defeated by Christ. "The last  
enemy that will be destroyed is death" (1  
Corinthians 15:26). Because Jesus rose from the  
dead, those who die in the Lord have a living hope.  
Paul wrote, "For if we believe that Jesus died and  
rose again, even so God will bring with Him those  
who sleep in Jesus" (1 Thessalonians 4:14). Our  
grief, therefore, is not without hope. We mourn, but  
not "as others who have no hope" (1 Thessalonians  
4:13).

For the Christian, death marks a transition, not an  
end. The faithful can rest in the promise that to  
depart and be with Christ is "far better"  
(Philippians 1:23). While we feel the pain of absence,  
we are comforted by the assurance that God is  
mindful of His children. "The LORD is near to  
those who have a broken heart" (Psalm 34:18). In  
moments when words fail, we can lean on God in  
prayer, trusting that He hears the cries of our  
hearts.

The church has a vital role in times of loss. We are  
members of one body (1 Corinthians 12:26), and  
when one member suffers, all suffer with them.  
Through presence, prayer, and practical help, we  
demonstrate the love of Christ to grieving families.  
Encouraging one another with God's promises  
strengthens faith and reminds us that our fellowship  
in Christ extends beyond this life.

Though death brings tears today, God promises a  
future without sorrow. "God will wipe away every  
tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death,  
nor sorrow, nor crying" (Revelation 21:4). Until that  
day, may we cling to the hope found in Christ,  
comfort one another with His word, and remain  
faithful as we await the resurrection.
