

Spend a Little Time With God

Spending time in God's Word is one of the most important habits a Christian can develop. In a fast-paced world filled with noise, distraction, and human opinion, the Bible remains our sure foundation. If we desire spiritual strength, clarity, and growth, we must be people of the Book.

Jesus prayed in John 17:17, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth." God's Word sets us apart from the world. It shapes our thinking, purifies our hearts, and aligns our lives with His will. Without consistent study, we slowly begin to think like the world rather than like Christ.

The prophet declared in Jeremiah 15:16, "Your words were found, and I ate them, and Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart." Notice the language, Jeremiah "ate" God's Word. Just as our physical bodies require daily nourishment, our souls require regular spiritual feeding. When we neglect Scripture, we become spiritually weak and malnourished.

God commanded Joshua in Joshua 1:8, "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night... For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success." True success is not measured by wealth or status, but by faithfulness to God. Meditation, thoughtful, consistent reflection on Scripture, leads to spiritual stability and wise decision-making.

Spending time in God's Word also guards us against sin. The psalmist asked in Book of Psalms 119:11, "Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You." When Scripture fills the heart, it influences our choices. It reminds us of God's standards in moments of temptation and strengthens us to choose righteousness.

Finally, regular Bible study draws us closer to God. The more we learn about His character, promises, and commands, the more we grow in reverence and love for Him. Time spent in Scripture is never wasted, it shapes eternity.

Let us commit to opening God's Word daily. A few consistent minutes each day will do more for our spiritual lives than hours spent on worldly pursuits. When we treasure the Word, we honor the God who gave it.
