Happy Mother's Day!

Mother's Day gives us a meaningful opportunity to reflect on one of God's greatest earthly blessings—the gift of mothers. While the Bible does not set aside a specific day for this occasion, it repeatedly teaches the importance of honoring and appreciating them.

God's command in Exodus 20:12 reminds us, "Honor your father and your mother." This principle is not limited to childhood—it is a lifelong responsibility. Mothers often display a remarkable combination of love, sacrifice, strength, and patience that leaves a lasting impression on the hearts and lives of their children.

Proverbs 31 offers a beautiful portrait of a godly woman. Her worth is described as "far above rubies" (v. 10), and her life is marked by diligence, wisdom, and kindness. "She opens her mouth with wisdom, and on her tongue is the law of kindness" (v. 26). Her children rise up and call her blessed (v. 28), not because she seeks praise, but because her life reflects steady, faithful devotion.

The New Testament highlights the powerful influence of a mother's faith. Paul spoke of the sincere faith found first in Timothy's grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice (2 Timothy 1:5). Their example shows how a mother's teaching and godly influence can shape a life devoted to serving the Lord.

A mother's love also provides a glimpse into the compassionate care of God. Isaiah 66:13 says, "As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you." Though no human love is perfect, the tenderness of a mother reflects something of God's own nature.

This Mother's Day, let us express our gratitude not only in words, but in actions. A phone call, a visit, or a simple expression of appreciation can go a long way. For those who find this day difficult, may we find comfort in God's presence and the spiritual family we share in Christ.

"Her children rise up and call her blessed" (Proverbs 31:28). May we do the same.
