The Wonderful Scene of the Mount of Transfiguration

Few events in the earthly ministry of Jesus reveal His divine glory as beautifully as the Mount of Transfiguration. Recorded in Matthew 17:1–8, Mark 9:2–8, and Luke 9:28–36, this remarkable event allowed Peter, James, and John to witness a glimpse of the majesty that belonged to Christ before He came into the world. It was a moment that strengthened the faith of these disciples and affirmed beyond question that Jesus is the Son of God.

The scene begins with Jesus leading Peter, James, and John up a high mountain to pray. While there, "He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light" (Matthew 17:2). The veil of His humanity was momentarily drawn back, revealing His divine splendor. The One who had walked dusty roads, healed the sick, and taught the multitudes was shown to be far more than a great teacher; He was God in the flesh.

Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared, speaking with Jesus. These two faithful servants represented the Law and the Prophets, both of which pointed forward to the coming Messiah. Their presence demonstrated that Jesus was the fulfillment of everything God had promised throughout the Old Testament. Luke tells us they spoke with Him concerning His "decease" which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem (Luke 9:31). Even in this glorious moment, the cross remained central to God's redemptive plan.

Peter, overwhelmed by the experience, suggested building three tabernacles: one for Jesus, one for Moses, and one for Elijah. Though well intentioned, Peter failed to recognize that Jesus was not merely equal with these great men of faith. Before he could finish speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and the voice of the Father declared, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" (Matthew 17:5). Those words forever settled the matter. The authority of Christ surpasses every prophet, every lawgiver, and every previous revelation. Today, we are called to listen to Him.

When the disciples looked up again, they "saw no one but Jesus only" (Matthew 17:8). What a powerful lesson for every generation. Moses had fulfilled his purpose. Elijah had completed his ministry. Now all attention belonged to Christ alone. Our faith is centered not in human traditions or personalities but in the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Mount of Transfiguration reminds us that Jesus possesses all authority and glory. It assures us that His sacrifice was God's eternal plan and that His kingdom is founded upon divine truth. As we journey through life's trials, we can remember that the One who humbled Himself to die upon the cross is also the glorified Son of God who now reigns in heaven. May we always keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, listen carefully to His Word, and follow Him faithfully until the day we share in His everlasting glory.
