You're Not Alone!

Few experiences in life are as heartbreaking as the loss of a child. It is a sorrow that defies words and leaves questions that cannot always be answered. As a congregation, our hearts are heavy as we grieve with D'Andre and Taylor League, and the Mullican family, following the loss of their precious newborn child on Saturday, July 18. While no words can remove such pain, God's Word reminds us that we do not bear our burdens alone.

The apostle Paul instructed Christians, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). This is a time for the Lord's church to do exactly that. We cannot take away their grief, but we can help carry it through our prayers, our presence, our kind words, and our acts of love. Sometimes the greatest ministry is simply sitting beside someone in silence, reminding them they are not alone.

Scripture assures us that God is near to those whose hearts are broken. "The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit" (Psalm 34:18). Though D'Andre and Taylor now walk through one of life's darkest valleys, they do not walk it by themselves. The Good Shepherd has promised, "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5). Even when tears seem endless and answers seem distant, God's presence remains steadfast.

The Bible also reminds us that our Savior understands grief. At the tomb of Lazarus, "Jesus wept" (John 11:35). Though He knew resurrection was moments away, He entered into the sorrow of those He loved. Christ's compassion teaches us that mourning is not a weakness but a natural expression of love. As followers of Jesus, we should never hesitate to weep with those who weep (Romans 12:15), offering the same compassion our Lord demonstrated.

For those who love D'Andre and Taylor, this is an opportunity to let your faith be seen. Continue praying for them in the weeks and months ahead. Send a note, offer a meal, share a comforting Scripture, or simply remind them that they are loved. Grief does not disappear after the funeral; it

often lingers long after others have returned to their normal routines. Our continued support can be a powerful reflection of Christ's love.

Finally, let us hold fast to the hope found in the promises of God. While sorrow is real, it is not the end of the story for those who belong to the Lord. Paul wrote, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation" (2 Corinthians 1:3-4). May that divine comfort surround D'Andre and Taylor in the days ahead, and may our congregation be an instrument of God's grace as we love them, pray for them, and walk beside them through this difficult journey.
